MONITORING

1. The presence of floating product shall be evaluated at each station identified on the attached map (Attachment 1) and for a minimum of 250 feet downstream of station No. 1 in Blue-Slide Creek.
2. Each monitoring station shall be sampled monthly. The analyses shall be performed at a certified laboratory for total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd), total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), dissolved oxygen (DO), temperature, and turbidity.

REPORTING

1. A scale map shall be submitted for each monthly event depicting sampling locations and locations of any identified floating product.
2. Each month's analytical results for TPHd, TPHg, PAHs, BTEX, DO, temperature, and turbidity shall be submitted in tabular form including all current and historic data.
3. Monthly monitoring reports shall be submitted to this office in accordance with the following schedule:
