DISCUSSION

This is an Order to rescind previously adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order Nos. 96-40, R1-2002-0009, 88-148, 91-23, 87-4, R1-2005-0069, 83-078, 84-13, 89-76, 89-96 and associated Monitoring and Reporting Programs (MRPs). These WDRs were historically issued to four domestic wastewater dischargers and six industrial waste dischargers in order to protect against potential impacts to ground and

surface water quality. These WDRs are no longer needed due to the cessation of the authorized discharge activities, or due to the discharge activities being authorized by other WDRs or by another agency. This Order will rescind ten WDRs Orders and associated MRPs which are no longer required for the protection of water quality.

A copy of the draft rescission was mailed to interested parties and a 30 day public comment period was noticed on the Regional Water Board website from November 16, 2011, to December 16, 2011.

Only one public comment was received during the 30-day public comment period. The comment was made by Granite Construction Company, the current owner of the former Parnum Paving gravel processing facility located at 4201 North State Street in Ukiah. Granite Construction Company requested that WDRs Order No. 80-100 for the former Parnum Paving facility be removed from the proposed Rescission Order "to ensure that no lapse in coverage occurs while we continue to work with staff on the appropriate permitting approach to cover our activities at the site". WDRs Order No. 80-100 has been pulled from the Rescission Order and Regional Water Board staff are working with Granite Construction Company on updating and revising the WDRs for the facility. No other public comments were received.
