BOARD ACTION: The Board will consider adoption of Order No. R1-2017-0003.

BACKGROUND: This is an Order to rescind previously adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Orders and a Cease and Desist Order (CDO) referenced above.

These orders were adopted by the Regional Water Board to protect against potential impacts to groundwater and surface water quality, but are no longer needed due to the cessation of the authorized activities, or permit coverage under other more appropriate permits due to completion of site remediation of the cleanup site taking place. This Order will rescind six WDR Orders and one CDO because these orders are no longer required for the protection of water quality.

DISCUSSION: A draft of this Order was available for public comment from October 10, 2016, to November 10, 2016. Comments were received on two of the WDR Orders originally proposed for rescission. The WDR Orders were for the Mendocino Forest Products Ukiah Sawmill and the Ecodyne Corporation. The dischargers of record for Mendocino Forest Products and Ecodyne Corporation requested removal of their respective WDRs from the subject rescission order because the discharge would continue to take place beyond the February 2, 2017 date of the Board meeting. Consequently, these two WDR Orders are no longer being proposed for rescission at this time.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Order No. R1-2017-0003, as proposed.
