SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution No. R1-2014-0010 Requesting the State Water Resources Control Board to Nominate Several Sites for the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund, Emergency, Abandoned, Recalcitrant (EAR) Account, Fiscal Year 14-15
(Craig Hunt)

BOARD ACTION: The Regional Water Board will consider adoption of Order No. R1-2014-0010.

BACKGROUND: Chapter 6.75 of the California Health and Safety Code authorizes the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) to provide Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Funds to the Regional Water Boards for initiating direct cleanup of petroleum underground tank sites requiring corrective action to protect human health, safety, and the environment.

Regional Water Board staff request that four sites be nominated. The sites are identified in the State Water Board's GeoTracker website as:

- Nancy Schultz located at 10138 Highway 199, Gasquet, Case #1TDN055
- Shell, Albion located at 3300 North Highway 1, Albion, Case #1TMC357
- Nelson, Alan & Karen, 327 Petaluma Avenue, Sebastopol, Case # 1TSO263, and
- Alliance Service Station (Former), now called North Gate Gas, 720 S. Main St., Sebastopol, Case #1TSO016.

ISSUES: All four sites are already on the statewide priority list for funding through the EAR account. Annual re-nomination of the sites by the Regional Water Board is necessary for work to continue on these sites through the EAR account. The previous 2013/2014 fiscal year nomination list also included three Humboldt County Local Oversight Program sites. The Humboldt County Local Oversight Program declined to renew those sites for the 2014/2015 fiscal year.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES: N/A
