WWTF, Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements for the CDF Trinity
River Conservation Camp WWTF, Order No. R1-2001-57; replaced by
General Order No. 97-10-DWQ.

DISCUSSION

This Order is to rescind the Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2001-57 for the CDF Trinity River Conservation Camp WWTF. Order No. R1-2001-57 has been replaced by General Order No. 97-10-DWQ.

On June 28, 2001, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2001-57, requiring the California Department of Forestry to comply with discharge specifications for sewage disposal and water recycling at the CDF Trinity River Conservation Camp, located in Lewiston, California. In 2006 the USFS upgraded the existing wastewater treatment system by installing treatment system and effluent spray field improvements.

Regulation of the wastewater treatment and disposal system will be in accordance with State Water Resources Control Board General Order No. 97-10-DWQ. Monitoring and Reporting to the Regional Water Board will be per compliance. New Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2008-0030 issued by the Executive Officer.

No public comments were received; this item is routine and non-controversial.
