

Schedule and Directions – May 4, 2011 tour of privately owned forest and ranch lands in the Blue Lake area, sponsored by The Buckeye Conservancy.

Directions to the tour meeting point: Take the Blue Lake exit off Highway 299. Go straight through the roundabout. Drive through Blue Lake. Just outside Blue Lake (to the east), there will be a parking lot on the left side where the tour will start at 1pm.

Boots are recommended. The first stop on the tour is the Bussman property. From there, we will car pool into four-wheel drive vehicles to the Devries property. If time permits, we may stop at the Samuels property. All three properties have Non-industrial Timber Management Plans in place.

The outdoor barbeque will be held at Camp Bauer in Korbekel, at about 5pm. The charge for the barbeque is \$10 per person. NO DOGS are allowed at Camp Bauer. The group will pass by the parking area for the car pool vehicles on the way to Camp Bauer.

Directions to Camp Bauer: Proceed through Korbekel past the mill and post office. After crossing the cement bridge over the North Fork of the Mad River, continue straight toward Maple Creek and very shortly (less than 0.1 mile) on the left there is a road and sign for Camp Bauer. There will be a gate guard at the turn off. From there to the barbeque spot is about 0.75 mile.
