SUBJECT: Public Hearing to Consider Adoption of Order No. R1-2009-0034 Rescinding Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2004-0012 and Monitoring and Reporting Program R1-2006-0079, for Exchange Bank Data Center, 330 Sebastopol Road, Santa Rosa, California

DISCUSSION

Order No. R1-2009-0034 is to rescind the Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2004-0012 and Monitoring and Reporting Program (M&RP) R1-2006-0079. On March 24, 2004, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2004-0012 requiring the Exchange Bank Data Center to comply with discharge prohibitions and effluent limitations for the in-situ treatment of contaminated groundwater at the facility in Santa Rosa, California. Order No. R1-2004-0012 also requires compliance with Contingency Planning and Notification Requirements Order No. 74-151 and M&RP No. R1-2004-0012. M&RP No. R1-2004-0012 was replaced on July 12, 2006 by M&RP No. R1-2006-0079.

Exchange Bank Data Center has completed all Regional Water Board corrective action requirements and the site has been approved for no further action. Because remedial activities conducted under Order No. R1-2004-0012 are no longer required, Order No. R1-2004-0012 and corresponding M&RP Order No. R1-2006-0079 should be rescinded.
