Notice of Public Comment Period, Public Hearing and Notice of Intent

to Adopt Mitigated Negative Declaration and Order No. R1-2016-0011,
Waste Discharge Requirements for McClelland Dairy West,
Sonoma County, California

North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will conduct a public hearing to consider adoption of proposed Order No. R1-2016-0011, *Waste Discharge Requirements for McClelland Dairy West* (WDR) and the associated California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) proposed Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (Mitigated Negative Declaration).

The WDR would prescribe requirements for discharges, or threatened discharges, of wastes, and organic materials, from the dairy operation and related land management activities on lands operated by the McClelland Dairy West, 5000 Llano Road, Santa Rosa, in the Laguna de Santa Rosa, a tributary stream to the Russian River in Sonoma County, California. Activities covered by the WDR include farming, milking operations, grazing animals, maintenance, reconstruction of barns, manure application to land, and water quality monitoring.

The proposed Order and Mitigated Negative Declaration is available for a 30-day public review, from May 27, 2016, to 5:00 P.M. on June 27, 2016. Persons wishing to comment in writing must submit comments to the Regional Water Board no later than the close of the 30-day public review period, approximately 5:00 P.M. on June 27, 2016, in order to ensure written responses to their comments prior to the Board hearing.
