

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CORRECTIVE ACTION

This notice invites the public to review and comment on the pending decision to implement a corrective action to remediate petroleum releases at the cleanup site known as Redwood Oil, Willits. The site is located at 110 North Main Street in Willits, California. Remedial action measures will be implemented after the close of the public comment period unless new and significant information is submitted that requires the corrective action plan to be revised.

### **Problem Description**

Petroleum hydrocarbon discharges to soil and groundwater occurred at 110 North Main Street, Willits, California from underground storage tanks and associated piping. Soil and groundwater cleanup activities have included removal of all underground tanks and piping with excavation of some impacted soil. The contaminants include gasoline, diesel, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, total xylenes, oxygenates including MTBE, and other petroleum hydrocarbon constituents.

### **Site Characterization**

Groundwater monitoring wells were installed to determine the impacts to water quality and to define the lateral and vertical extent of groundwater contamination. Continued monitoring has provided information to conclude the extent of contamination has generally been defined.

### **Proposed Remedial Action**

The responsible party for the site proposes to remediate the site by a combination of engineered remediation through dual phase extraction (DPE) and monitored natural attenuation (MNA). DPE consists of removing vapor and groundwater from the subsurface, treating each media above ground, followed by the disposal of the treated waste under appropriate permits.

The proposed action will be approved without further notice unless significant public comment is received by February 21, 2011.
