

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CORRECTIVE ACTION

This notice invites the public to review and comment on the pending decision to implement a corrective action to remediate petroleum releases at the cleanup site known as Hopper's Corner Store. The site is located at 10010 Main Street, Potter Valley, California. Remedial action measures will be implemented after the close of the public comment period unless new and significant information is submitted that requires the corrective action plan to be revised.

Problem Description

Petroleum hydrocarbon discharges to soil and groundwater occurred at 10010 Main Street, Potter Valley, California from underground storage tanks and associated piping. Soil and groundwater cleanup activities have included removal and replacement of underground tanks and piping. Groundwater remains impacted and significant soil contamination exists in the upper 15 feet near the former underground tanks and piping.

Site Characterization

Groundwater monitoring wells have been installed to define the lateral and vertical extent of groundwater contamination. Groundwater contaminants include gasoline, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene, and fuel oxygenates. Significant soil contamination persists and continues to provide a source for groundwater contamination.

Proposed Remedial Action

The responsible party for the site proposes to remove approximately 150 cubic yards of soils in the upper 15 feet of the site. In addition, impacted groundwater is anticipated to be pumped from the excavation. Impacted soils and groundwater will be disposed of at an appropriately permitted facility.

The proposed action will be approved without further notice unless significant public comment is received by **February 24, 2011**.
