This notice invites the public to review and comment on the pending decision to implement a corrective action for hydrocarbon releases at the property known as the Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) Ukiah Service Center. PG&E is the current owner of the Site located at 2641 North State Street, Ukiah, CA.

Problem Description

Site investigations indicated that total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline, methyl tert-butyl ether, and tert-butyl alcohol have contaminated soil and groundwater at the PG&E Service Center.

Proposed Corrective Action

The Feasibility Study/Corrective Action Plan proposes to conduct groundwater extraction and treatment in conjunction with enhanced in-situ aerobic bioremediation followed by monitored natural attenuation.

Regional Water Board staff will concur with the proposed action without further notice unless significant public comment is received by September 24, 2012.
