

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CORRECTIVE ACTION

The public is invited to review and comment on the pending decision to implement corrective action for petroleum releases at the property known as the Taylor Bus site located at 1175 Sebastopol Road in Santa Rosa.

Problem Description

The site is currently occupied by a trucking company. In the past, the site contained above ground storage tanks and underground storage tanks that dispensed gasoline and diesel. Leaks from the tank systems resulted in the discharge of fuels to soil and groundwater. Subsurface investigations have been conducted at the site. Current conditions indicate the presence of significant fuel impacts in the southern portion of the site near Sebastopol Road.

Proposed Corrective Action

A 5-day pilot test using dual phase extraction of soil vapor and groundwater was performed in 2013. Results of the pilot test were favorable for the removal of fuels from the subsurface. The proposed remedial action is to perform dual phase extraction for a 30-day period in the southern portion of the site.

The proposed action will be approved without further notice unless significant public comment or new information is received by February 24, 2014.
