NOTICE OF PROPOSED CORRECTIVE ACTION

The public is invited to review and comment on the pending decision to implement corrective action for petroleum releases at the property known as the Chevron #9-2642/Redwood Oil site located at 1100 Bennett Valley Road in Santa Rosa.

Problem Description

The Chevron/Redwood Oil site is an operating service station. Historic leaks from the underground storage tank systems resulted in the discharge of fuels to soil and groundwater. Subsurface investigations have been conducted at the site. Current conditions indicate the presence of significant fuel impacts, including gasoline, benzene, and MTBE dissolved in shallow groundwater under the gas station and in the residential area west of the site.

Proposed Corrective Action

Environmental consultants propose to install an engineered trench on a vacant lot located at 1016 Bennett Valley Road about 200 feet west of the site. Groundwater will be extracted from the trench using a vacuum extraction truck and hauled away. During operations, the trench will be backfilled and the vacant lot will be securely fenced. Groundwater will also be extracted from select groundwater monitoring wells located on Hendley Street near Bennett Valley Road. Groundwater extraction will be performed every month for 6 months, and may continue beyond 6 months if needed.

The proposed action will be approved without further notice unless significant public comment or new information is received by April 8, 2015.
