On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, proposes to revise Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R1-2001-9. The requirements will also serve as our general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit No. CAG911001.

WDRs Order No. R1-2002-9 was adopted by the North Coast Regional Water Board on September 13, 2002, for discharges of extracted and highly treated groundwater to surface water. MGM Brakes proposes to increase the flow to the groundwater extraction system from a maximum of 20 gallons per minute (gpm) to a maximum of 40 gpm. An air stripper has also been added to the treatment system. The groundwater extraction system removes and treats volatile organic compounds and petroleum hydrocarbon impacted water for site remediation. The discharge of groundwater to the storm drain system containing detectable levels of petroleum or volatile organic compounds is prohibited. The storm drain discharges to an unnamed tributary to Porterfield Creek and the Russian River.
