**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE
DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R1-2004-0021**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2004-0021 (Order) for Chevron #9-6309 (Ginn Property), 6490 Front Street, Forestville, California (Site). A release from the former underground gasoline storage tanks discharged petroleum hydrocarbons and associated chemicals to the subsurface that have impacted groundwater. As part of the approved remedial action plan, the discharger proposes to use Sulfate Enhanced Bioremediation to clean up petroleum hydrocarbons in the soil and groundwater. On May 12, 2004, the Regional Water Board adopted General Order No. R1-2004-0021 for the addition of nutrients, microorganisms, and/or an oxygen source to soils and/or groundwater. Therefore, all sites injecting nutrients, microorganisms and/or oxygen must be covered under Order No. R1-2004-0021.

Coverage under Order No. R1-2004-0021 will be extended after thirty days from the date of publication and posting of this notice, unless the Executive Officer receives information that the project may not meet the intent of the Order.
