

**NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF COVERAGE UNDER
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

On the basis of staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) intends to extend coverage under *General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2009-0105 for In Situ Soil and Groundwater Remediation for Volatile Organic Compound and/or Metal Impacted Sites within the North Coast Region* (General WDR) for a groundwater remediation project proposed at 2231 Mendocino Avenue in Santa Rosa, California (the Site). The General WDR was adopted by the Regional Water Board on December 10, 2009.

The proposed project is intended to reduce or eliminate tetrachloroethene (PCE) and related volatile organic compounds (VOCs) from groundwater at the Site. A *Notice of Intent* (NOI) was submitted to this office proposing the injection of a commercial product, 3DME™, which will promote reductive dechlorination of contaminants in groundwater. Reductive dechlorination is the mechanism by which subsurface microbes (bacteria) degrade VOCs into less harmful constituents. This technology has been shown to be effective for reducing VOC concentrations in groundwater. The Regional Water Board Executive Officer may extend coverage under Order R1-2009-0105 for the proposed project without further public notice unless significant comments are received by the end of the comment period.
