

NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF COVERAGE UNDER
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, proposes to extend coverage to Weeks Drilling & Pump, located at 6100 Sebastopol Road, in Sebastopol, California, under General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R1-2011-0028 for discharges of highly treated groundwater to surface water. The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted General Order No. R1-2011-0028 National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CAG911001 *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Highly Treated Groundwater to Surface Waters Following Extraction and Treatment of Groundwater Polluted with Petroleum Hydrocarbons and Volatile Organic Compounds* on May 5, 2011. The discharger intends to operate a groundwater extraction system at the site to cleanup groundwater impacted with petroleum hydrocarbons. Extracted groundwater will be treated by an activated carbon system and discharged to a tributary to the Laguna de Santa Rosa. The Laguna de Santa Rosa is a tributary to the Russian River.
