The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Water Board) is proposing concurrence with the addition of chemical oxidants as an interim remedial action technology to treat residual organic contamination (including pentachlorophenol and dioxins/furans) in soil and groundwater at the above named Site. This remedial technology will require coverage under General Waste Discharge Requirement Order No. R1-2006-0107. The proposed remedial action to cleanup release(s) from the former operations at the Site is an oxidation technology. The introduction of oxidants is intended to remediate residual organic contaminants in soil and groundwater to concentrations approaching or below numeric water quality objectives.
