This notice invites public comment on the proposed decision to authorize the treatment of petroleum contaminated soil at the above-referenced address in accordance with the provisions of *General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 92-66*. Order 92-66 was adopted by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board to regulate the storage and treatment of soil contaminated by petroleum hydrocarbons and other biodegradable substances. Eel River Fuels, Inc. has submitted a Notice of Intent for coverage under Order 92-66.

Eel River Fuels, Inc. proposes to treat approximately 7000 cubic yards of excavated soil on portions of the Hay Industrial Park in Point Arena, CA, to clean up diesel impacts from leaking above-ground storage tanks that were formerly located at the site. The proposed treatment processes include aeration and biological degradation to reduce petroleum compounds in soil to levels that are consistent with unrestricted future land uses and will not pose a threat to nearby streams or to groundwater.

A detailed description of the proposed project is contained in the December 30, 2015 "Proposed Remediation Plan and Notice of Intent to Comply with Waste Discharge Requirement 92-66."
