This notice invites public comment on the proposed decision to authorize groundwater remediation activities at the above-referenced site under the regulatory provisions specified in "Order No. R1-2009-0105, General Waste Discharge Requirements for In Situ Soil and Groundwater Remediation of Volatile Organic Compound and/or Metal Impacted Sites within the North Coast Region."

Groundwater beneath the site is impacted by volatile organic compounds (VOCs). HP Inc. now proposes to inject non-toxic chemical amendments into groundwater to remediate the VOCs to acceptable levels. The amendments proposed to be injected include a carbon substrate mixture consisting of emulsified vegetable oil and ethyl lactate, and a microbial culture capable of degrading the VOCs to non-toxic chemical end products.

A detailed description of the proposed activities is contained in the "Enhanced In Situ Bioremediation Work Plan, Building 2T Remedial Area," dated March 24, 2016, which is available for review on the State's internet "GeoTracker" database at the following link: http://geotracker.waterboards.ca.gov/profile_report.asp?global_id=T0609791161.

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this proposal, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with issuance of coverage under Order R1-2009-0105 upon conclusion of the comment period.
