

NOTICE OF INTENT
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR
DISCHARGES TO LAND BY SMALL DOMESTIC WASTEWATER TREATMENT
SYSTEMS

The Lewis RV Park Facility (Facility) located at 28101 Avenue of the Giants in Redcrest, California, is a 49 space seasonal recreation vehicle park located along the Avenue of the Giants. Sanitary sewer service is provided by an onsite wastewater system consisting of thirteen (13) septic tanks for 49 RV spaces, plus additional tanks for the laundry facility the laundry facility. Prior to distribution into the leachfield there is a five-tank tank complex which includes one pump tank to transport effluent to the vicinity of the leachfield, and a final pump tank which will dose the leachfield, twenty (20) tanks total. At the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff's request, the Facility submitted a report of waste discharge (ROWD). On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, intends to enroll the Facility under *General Waste Discharge Requirements For Discharges To Land By Small Domestic Wastewater Treatment Systems Water Quality Order No. 97-10-DWQ*.

The public comment period will be completed 30-days from the issuance of this notice.
