NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

FOR VIOLATIONS ALLEGED

On January 28, 2010, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) Prosecution Team entered into a tentative settlement to resolve the effluent limit violations alleged in Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R1-2009-0131 (Complaint) issued to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (Discharger). Per the terms of settlement set forth in the Waiver Form, the Discharger waived the right to a hearing before the Regional Board and submitted a payment of the total assessed penalty, \$6,000. Persons may comment on the proposed settlement by submitting written comments so that they are received no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 9, 2010. Written comments should include "ACL Complaint No. R1-2009-0131" in the subject line, and should be submitted to the attention of Nick Weil at 5550 Skylane Blvd., Suite A, Santa Rosa, CA 95403 or nweil@waterboards.ca.gov. Should the Regional Water Board receive significant new information or comments from any source (excluding the Water Board's Prosecution Team) during this comment period, the Regional Water Board's Assistant Executive Officer may withdraw the Complaint, return payment, and issue a new complaint. If no significant new information or comments are received, this tentative settlement shall become final on April 12, 2010.
