NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) on September 29, 2011 to consider adoption of a proposed Policy for Implementation of the Water Quality Objective for Temperature. The purpose of the policy is to provide a comprehensive framework to implement the water quality objective for temperature throughout the North Coast Region. The goals of the proposed Policy are to control elevated water temperature in water bodies so that water quality objectives are attained and beneficial uses are not adversely affected by elevated temperatures.
