On January 19, 2012, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) will consider approval of an Administrative Civil Liability Order, No. R1-2012-0014 (Order) that describes a proposed settlement with the City of Crescent City WWTF (Discharger) to resolve violations subject to mandatory minimum penalties alleged in Complaint No. R1-2011-0093. The Complaint proposed that the Regional Water Board assess mandatory minimum penalties in the amount of \$186,000 for violations of effluent limits. Persons may comment on the proposed settlement and/or Order by submitting written comments so that they are received no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 30, 2011. Written comments should include "Settlement Agreement and Stipulation for Entry of Order and Administrative Civil Liability Order No. R1-2011-0014" in the subject line, and should be submitted to the attention of Nancy Robinson by mail at 5550 Skylane Blvd., Suite A, Santa Rosa, CA 95403 or email at nrobinson@waterboards.ca.gov. If the written material is more than five (5) pages or contains foldouts, maps, etc., twenty (20) copies must be submitted for distribution to the Regional Board members and staff, and for distribution to the public at the Regional Water Board meeting. E-mail comments on this matter will be accepted and provided to the Regional Water Board as long as the total submittal (including attachments) does not exceed five (5) printed pages in length. If the Regional Water Board does not adopt the proposed Order, the matter may be scheduled for an evidentiary hearing at a subsequent Regional Water Board meeting.
