On the basis of preliminary staff review and application of lawful standards and regulations, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region, proposes to issue waste discharge requirements for the Santa Rosa Subregional Water Reclamation System. The requirements will also serve as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for a period of five years.

A public meeting to consider comments to the proposed order was originally scheduled for January 24, 2013. A significant number of comments were submitted during the public review period. In order to provide adequate time for Regional Water Board staff to prepare responses to comments to the draft Order, the public meeting scheduled January 24, 2013 has been rescheduled to March 14, 2013 at 8:30 a.m. or as announced in the Regional Water Board's agenda to be mailed on February 20, 2013. The meeting will be held in the Regional Water Quality Control Board Hearing Room, located at 5550 Skylane Boulevard, Suite A, in Santa Rosa, California.
