Problem Description

This site was formerly a bulk petroleum facility. Environmental investigation found that soil and groundwater were impacted with petroleum at the site. The extent of affected soil and affected groundwater was defined.

Actions Completed

Groundwater monitoring wells were installed and sampled over time. Although this is not an underground storage tank cleanup case, this site meets the closure criteria set forth in the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy" for petroleum contamination.

Proposed Action

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the "no further action" determination upon conclusion of the comment period.
