Problem Description

An unauthorized discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons was discovered at the above-referenced site during the removal of underground storage tanks. Subsurface investigation was conducted to define the extent of contamination in soil and groundwater, and lead to implementation of corrective action including over-excavation, soil vapor extraction and air sparging. No water supply wells were impacted by the contamination.

Proposed Action

A "no further action" determination related to the discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons is proposed. Although significant petroleum contamination remains in the subsurface, the site meets the case closure criteria specified by the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy."

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the "no further action" determination upon conclusion of the comment period.
