Problem Description

An unauthorized discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons was discovered at the above-referenced site during the removal of an underground storage tank. Subsurface investigation was conducted to define the extent of contamination in soil and groundwater. Contaminated soil was removed to the extent feasible and no further action appears appropriate. No water supply wells were impacted by the contamination.

Proposed Action

A "no further action" determination related to the discharge of petroleum hydrocarbons is proposed.

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the "no further action" determination upon conclusion of the comment period.
