Problem Description

During a routine inspection, stained soil was observed south of the fueling area, presumably from over filling from an above ground storage tank.

Actions Completed

In 1997, approximately 120 cubic yards of soil was excavated and replaced with clean material. Confirmation sampling indicated the majority of the impacted soil was effectively removed. Four groundwater monitoring wells were then installed and monitored to evaluate potential impact to groundwater.

In October 2014, an additional 100 cubic yards of impacted material was excavated. Clean river run fill material was imported from the Mad River and placed in the excavation, and the contaminated material was properly disposed of.

Proposed Action

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the “no further action” determination upon conclusion of the comment period.
