NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) on September 29, 2011 to consider adoption of a proposed editorial amendment to Chapter 2 – Beneficial Uses of the *Water Quality Control Plan for the North Coast Region* (Basin Plan). The purpose of the amendment is to revise the Basin Plan to make it more user-friendly by updating descriptive language, correction of typographical errors, reformatting to aid in the reader's use, etc.

EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT: The written comments on the proposed Basin Plan amendment began on August 19, 2011 and will remain open until 10:00 am on September 29, 2011. LEGAL BASIS FOR ACTION: California Water Code §13240 authorizes the Regional Water Board to revise the Basin Plan as needed. These revisions must be in accordance with the notice and hearing requirements of California Water Code §13244, 23 CCR §3777, and 40 CFR §25.5. This amendment will not alter any regulatory element of the Basin Plan, and therefore can be submitted as a "Change Without Regulatory Effect" (1 CCR §100). The amendment has no potential for any direct or indirect change to the environment.
