Urban Water Suppliers Water Conservation Efforts to be Discussed by State Water Board June 17

What: Water conservation efforts by urban water suppliers will be discussed before the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) during an informational Board discussion item June 17 intended to solicit urban water supplier input on the effectiveness of actions being taken to reduce water usage, as called for by the Governor in his January 17, 2014 Emergency Drought Proclamation.

- The meeting is an opportunity for water suppliers to share their progress in conserving water, and share their plans to increase conservation efforts as water supplies decrease.
- The State Water Board is interested in this testimony, because it will determine whether or not it needs to craft emergency regulations to assist water agencies in meeting these conservation goals.
