What: The State Water Resources Control Board is conducting a half-day <u>Urban Water</u>

<u>Conservation Workshop</u> in Los Angeles at 9 a.m., Dec. 17 in the boardroom of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California.

The purpose of the public workshop is to allow the public, water purveyors and other interested parties to discuss potential next steps and future actions the State Water Board could consider related to urban water conservation if drought conditions persist into 2015. Members of the public, water purveyors and the environmental community are scheduled to testify during the workshop.

This will be an informational workshop only and the State Water Board will take no action. The <u>call for a workshop</u> was made Dec. 2 when the State Water Board discussed trends in monthly water use statewide. The reporting of monthly water use became a requirement through an <u>emergency water conservation regulation</u> adopted by the board in July.
