A permanent reduction of exports must happen to protect the Delta. The current level of water exports exceeded the limit in the late 1990's and is unsustainable.

I do not want to see a weakening of salinity standards in the South Delta. Water quality standards must be protected for Delta agriculture, for other irrigation uses, and for recreation.
