We appreciate the Regional Board staff and management as well as the other stakeholders that have participated in developing the comprehensive Central Valley-wide Salt and Nitrate Management Plan (SNMP). The strategies and policies contained in the SNMP are reflected in the Draft Amendments to the Water Quality Control Plans for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and Tulare Lake Basin to Incorporate a Central Valley-wide Salt and Nitrate Control Program (Draft Amendments) as approved by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board on May 31, 2018.
