7. Content of communication

State Water Board staff has reached out to stakeholders in the above matter to offer an opportunity to hear a presentation by staff on the content of the proposed order issued February 8, 2016, and to ask

clarifying questions. This meeting took place as a result of the staff stakeholder outreach effort and was joined also by Board Member D'Adamo by phone.

State Water Board staff's presentation was an overview of the revisions proposed to be made to the Eastern San Joaquin Agricultural General Waste Discharge Requirements by the proposed order. The presentation tracked the discussion in the proposed order.

The attendees asked a number of clarifying questions at the meeting. The questions generally focused on clarification regarding the interpretation and implementation of revisions proposed. In particular, attendees asked:

- Whether the A/R ratio is expected to become a regulatory target for purposes of enforcement;
- Whether the water boards are developing a statewide database to receive the proposed reportable data;
- Whether the State Water Board would consider a stay of existing WDR provisions to avoid stranded costs;
- Whether the State Water Board has conducted any analysis of the increase in staffing and fees for the agricultural community;
- Whether the State Water Board is concerned with misinterpretation or misuse of the proposed reportable data;
- How the State Water Board views the scope of the precedent that may be established with the proposed order, including whether the precedent will acknowledge regional geologic variation.
