7. Content of communication

State Water Board staff has reached out to stakeholders in the above matter to offer an opportunity to hear a presentation by staff on the content of the proposed order issued February 8, 2016, and to ask clarifying questions. This meeting took place as a result of the staff stakeholder outreach effort and was attended also by Board Member D'Adamo.

State Water Board staff's presentation was an overview of the revisions proposed to be made to the Eastern San Joaquin Agricultural General Waste Discharge Requirements by the proposed order. The presentation tracked the discussion in the proposed order.

Farm Bureau representatives asked a number of clarifying questions at the meeting. The questions generally focused on clarification regarding the interpretation and implementation of revisions proposed. Farm Bureau representatives additionally inquired about the purpose of the new reporting requirements that direct the coalition to submit certain data to the regional water board at the field level beginning in 2019 and in particular inquired whether the water board would be willing to state that the data would not be used for enforcement purposes. Farm Bureau representatives also inquired about whether State Water Board staff has considered the implications of the proposed order with regard to potential litigation against growers. Farm Bureau staff additionally asked if the State Water Board would consider a written request to postpone the workshop and extend the public comment period to allow for additional time for the regulated community to review the order and prepare comments.
