Dear Ms. Creedon,

The East San Joaquin Water Quality Coalition (ESJWQC) is submitting an updated Pesticide Use Report (PUR) databases submitted as part of the Annual Monitoring Report (AMR) submitted on March 1, 2011. At the time of submittal, the ESJWQC had not received PUR data for Madera, Merced or Stanislaus Counties for December 2010 and therefore committed to submitting an addendum to the AMR on June 1, 2011 (page 102, Table 31 of the ESJWQC March 1, 2011 AMR). This addendum was to include additional PUR data related to the diuron exceedance at Mootz Drain downstream of Langworth Pond on December 14, 2010 (Stanislaus County); however, there were no diuron applications associated with the exceedance. All other exceedances that occurred in 2010 had complete PUR data in the original Appendix IV submitted on March 1, 2011. Therefore, this addendum only includes an electronic database with updated PUR data through December 2010 for all counties within the ESJWQC.
