Subject: SJR TMDL Meeting Follow-up

Good Morning ESJWQC and Westside Representatives,

This is a brief follow-up regarding the action items that were identified during our 3 May 2011 SJR TMDL Meeting.

Regional Board Next Steps

The Regional Board staff are discussing internally how the SJR should be monitored to most effectively characterize chlorpyrifos and diazinon concentrations in the river. I will set up a conference call in the near future to further discuss the monitoring aspects of the TMDL with the Coalitions.

Coalitions' Proposed SJR Exceedance Actions

The ESJWQC and Westside Coalition agreed to develop a process (maybe a decision tree) for timely follow-up actions when monitoring results show that the main stem SJR is out of compliance with the requirements of the TMDL. The proposed actions need to be responsive and specific, including a time frame for proposed actions.

Please let me know the current status of preparing a draft of your proposed non-compliance process/actions. Ideally we could also discuss this item in the next SJR TMDL conference call/meeting.
