Dan Hammer is the co-founder of the Earth Genome, a nonprofit that builds digital access to environmental data, partnering with organizations like the Brazos River Authority in Texas and the Tulare and Madera Irrigation Districts in the Central Valley. Dan served as the Senior Policy Advisor to the U.S. Chief Technology Officer in the Obama Administration.

He was the Presidential Innovation Fellow at NASA, where he released the first API listing for the agency. He also served as the Chief Data Scientist at the World Resources Institute and cofounded Global Forest Watch to monitor deforestation from satellite imagery. He is a PhD candidate at UC Berkeley, and was lead math instructor for the Prison University Project at San Quentin State Prison.
