ORDER NO. 87-126

AN ORDER RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS NOS. 602 AND 767 AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDERS NOS. 73-37 AND 77-34 ISSUED TO CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, INDUSTRIAL WASTE TREATMENT PLANT

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, (hereinafter Board) finds that:

1. The Board adopted waste discharge requirements for the City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco International Airport, Industrial Waste Treatment Plant (hereinafter discharger) in Resolutions Nos. 499 and 692, and in Orders Nos. 75-76 and 77-25 on September 19, 1963, August 19, 1965, November 18, 1975 and March 15, 1977, respectively. The discharger had to construct treatment plant improvements to achieve compliance with the waste discharge requirements. The following Resolutions and Cease and Desist Orders generally established time schedules for completion of the necessary improvements.
2. On October 15, 1964, the Board adopted Resolution No. 602 requiring the discharger to cease and desist from discharging waste in violation of the requirements of Resolution No. 499.
3. On June 16, 1966, the Board adopted Resolution No. 767 revising the compliance time schedule of Resolution No. 602.
4. On June 26, 1973, the Board adopted Cease and Desist Order No. 73-37 requiring the discharger to cease and desist from discharging wastes in violation of the requirements of Resolutions Nos. 499 and 692.
5. On April 19, 1977, the Board adopted Cease and Desist Order No. 77-34 requiring the discharger to cease and desist from discharging wastes in violation of requirements of Resolutions Nos. 499 and 692 and Orders Nos. 75-76 and 77-25.
6. The Board finds that the discharger has achieved consistent compliance with the requirements of Resolutions Nos. 499 and 692 and Orders Nos. 75-76 and 77-25 whose violation formed the basis for issuance of Resolutions Nos. 602 and 767 and Cease and Desist Orders Nos. 73-37 and 77-34.
7. The Board finds that this action is to rescind orders to enforce waste discharge requirements previously adopted by the Board. This action is, therefore, categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15321 of the California Natural Resources Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Resolutions Nos. 602 and 767 and Cease and Desist Orders Nos. 73-37 and 77-34 are rescinded in accordance with Sections 13301 and 13306 of the California Water Code.
