**NOTICE OF APPLICATION, OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Delta Diablo, Delta Diablo Wastewater Treatment Plant
2500 Pittsburg-Antioch Highway, Pittsburg, Contra Costa County**

The above discharger has filed an application for permit reissuance under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. The Board's staff has prepared a tentative permit in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The discharger owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant that treats about 13 million gallons per day (MGD) of domestic and industrial wastewater from Pittsburg, Antioch, and Bay Point. The Discharger treats the wastewater to national standards, and provides advanced treatment of about 6 MGD for recycling. Treated wastewater is discharged about 500 feet offshore at a depth of 26 feet to New York Slough opposite of Winter Island.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the tentative permit is 5:00 p.m. on July 7, 2014. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Vincent Christian**. Persons wishing to file written comments or objections to the tentative permit or other aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the tentative permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on August 13, 2014, in the Auditorium of the Elihu Harris Building at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party that challenges the Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence.

All documents related to the tentative permit may be inspected and copied at the Board office.
