In an effort to mitigate mercury transport from the historic Gambonini mine, EPA and the Water Board initiated an emergency Superfund (CERCLA) cleanup action in August 1999.

This mine cleanup leveraged state and federal dollars with low-cost and low-tech revegetation and erosion control measures to an unprecedented degree and is a unique success story.

The Marin Conservation Corps worked onsite with EPA, and the Marin Resource Conservation District continues to promote downstream watershed management.

DIRECTIONS TO GAMBONINI MINE SITE:

LOCATION: 1403 Marshall-Petaluma Road

Just **PAST** residence at 1402 Marshall-Petaluma Road
-gated entrance (on right following directions below)

from 101 N – take the **San Marin Dr / Atherton exit**
LEFT at traffic light after exiting onto **San Marin Dr.**

a few miles down San Marin Dr. just after passing the high school
RIGHT at stop sign onto **Novato Blvd.**

several miles on Novato Blvd., then
RIGHT at “T” intersection onto **Petaluma-Point Reyes Rd.**

almost immediately
FIRST LEFT onto **Wilson Hill Rd.** (also called **Hicks Valley Rd.**)

a few miles on Wilson Hill Rd.
LEFT at “Y” onto **Marshall-Petaluma Road**

Drive 3.1 miles and the mine entrance will be **on the right**

Directions from Petaluma

Start out going **Southwest** on **WESTERN AVE** toward **SPRING HILL RD.**

Turn **LEFT** onto **CHILENO VALLEY RD.**

Stay straight to go onto **WILSON HILL RD.**

WILSON HILL RD becomes **MARSHALL PETALUMA RD.**

Drive 3.1 miles and the mine entrance will be **on the right**
