

Justification

Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot (Attach additional photos as necessary):

The City of Fremont's Environmental Services Division conducts over 10 creek/street cleanups per year. As a result of these cleanups, the amount of pounds was counted each cleanup and annually over time. This creek was selected as the top seven hot spots that contain the most trash present through either multiple or all the following ways: accumulation, littering, windblown, or illegal dumping.

Line B Hot Spot receives trash by littering, illegal dumping and accumulation from nearby fast food retail and multi-family dwellings. In addition, the accumulation of and windblown trash comes from Fremont Boulevard, a high traffic thoroughfare, and Washington High School.

Upstream from this location, Line B is more vegetated catching larger debris and trash. The Line B hot spot consists of smaller materials invisible to quick visual inspections and a camera. During creek/street cleanups, Line B Hot Spot and over 1,200 yards upstream are cleaned at least once per year.
