## Site Information

**Waterbody:** Bernal Avenue Waterway

**Site Location:** This location is 3,700 feet east of I-680 on Bernal Avenue. The location is directly across from Bernal Avenue at the south end of the Alameda County Fairgrounds.

## Justification

### Information Supporting Selection as a Hot Spot:

This ditch is next to a main thoroughfare leading from I-680 to both the Alameda County Fairgrounds and downtown Pleasanton. There are restaurants, fast food eateries and a 24-hour gas station/mini market within a quarter mile of the ditch. Both the fairgrounds and the downtown area are major weekend destinations for out-of-town visitors. The location is one of the few waterways in the City of Pleasanton that has been monitored in the past for collecting trash. After looking at other areas along creeks and drainage ditches in Pleasanton, we decided this location would be a good place to concentrate our efforts.
