<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The purpose of this project is to replace a temporarily repaired culvert with a permanent, properly sized culvert.</p> <p>The project activities includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Replacing the existing repaired culvert with a 10-foot tall by 10-foot wide and 24.23 feet long pre-cast reinforced single box culvert;</li><li>• Finishing the culvert's inlet and outlet with concrete headwalls, end-walls, and wing-walls, with heights up to 14 feet;</li><li>• Installing un-grouted riprap aprons overlaying filter fabric at the culvert inlet and outlet;</li><li>• Hydroseeding the exposed slopes and stabilizing them with jute netting and straw wattles.</li></ul> <p>No compensatory mitigation was required for this project.</p>

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
