**This Action..... Rescind Waste Discharge Requirements**

**DISCUSSION**

On May 12, 1995, the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Coast Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. 95-21 to regulate the discharge of vegetable washwater at the Frank Capurro and Son Vegetable Packing Facility. On May 22, 2011, the discharger submitted updated information describing its discharge. The discharger reports that, as of June 15, 2010, there is no wash water being discharged, nor are there plans to discharge washwater. Staff inspected the facility on February 24, 2011, and affirms that there is no wash water being discharged. Because there is no vegetable washwater being discharged, WDRs Order No. 95-21 is unnecessary. Water Board staff recommends that the Central Coast Water Board rescind Order No. 95-21.
