### NOTICE OF REVISED PUBLIC MEETING DATE AND VENUE

#### **277 LOWER WALDEN RD, CARMEL HIGHLANDS (APN: 241-241-009), MONTEREY COUNTY; PROPOSED WAIVER OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALTERNATIVE ONSITE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM (RESOLUTION R3-2009-0057)**

The previously noticed September 11, 2009 public meeting date for this item, which was communicated to you in our July 8, 2009 letter, has been cancelled.

Consistent with our original July 8, 2009 letter/public hearing notice, we intend to recommend the Regional Water Board waive waste discharge requirements for the proposed engineered system at the newly scheduled public meeting.

Please note the public comment period for this item has not been changed. For clarification, interested persons are invited to submit comments regarding the proposed waiver resolution in writing to the Central Coast Water Board at its office in San Luis Obispo no later than August 13, 2009. All comments or objections received prior to that date will be considered in the

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formulation of staff recommendations regarding the waste discharge. The Central Coast Water Board will not accept comments or other written submissions on the draft Waiver after **August 13, 2009**, unless the Central Coast Water Board Chair rules that exclusion would create a severe hardship, and that the late submission will not prejudice any party or the Central Coast Water Board. Any person submitting late comments must explain why the materials were not submitted by August 13, 2009. The Central Coast Water Board Chairman will rule on late submittals at or before the hearing. Late submissions that consist of evidence (as opposed to policy statements or comments) are generally prejudicial unless all designated parties and Central Coast Water Board staff have time to consider the evidence before the hearing.

Interested persons are invited to attend the hearing at any of the above noted locations and may make oral comments relevant to the proposed action. Oral comments should summarize written comments. The Chair of the Central Coast Water Board will impose time limits on oral comments.
