DISCUSSION

The Water Board began regulating wastewater discharges from Sensient Dehydrated Flavors facility (formerly Rogers Foods Incorporated, Chili Products Division, Universal Foods Corporation) in 1986. Since then, the discharger ceased all vegetable processing, does not plan on discharging any additional wastewater, and the property is for sale. Also, the discharger requested a rescission of waste discharge requirements. Therefore, staff recommends the Water Board rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 99-008.
