Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to expand two existing 60-inch diameter corrugated metal culverts on to support the widening of an existing driveway for the purposes of accommodating emergency vehicles.</p> <p>The project activities includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expanding the existing 60-inch culvert, 4-feet on the western side and 5-feet on the eastern side; • Distributing approximately 67 cubic yards of riprap on the intake and outfall sides of the culvert; • Installing an additional 18-inch culvert extension upstream and east of the driveway; • Extending the 18-inch culvert approximately 12-feet and reinforcing it with 2 cubic yards of riprap; • Removing approximately 67 cubic yards of soil; • Directly impacting 5 mature coast live oaks and indirectly impacting 2 mature coast live oaks; and, • Mitigating impacts to oaks at a 4:1 and 2:1 ratio for direct and indirect impacts. <p>Proposed compensatory mitigation includes: enhancing 0.007 acres of streambed and 0.062 acres of riparian habitat.</p> <p>The County of San Luis Obispo filed a (Mitigated) Negative Declaration.</p>
