<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The purpose of this project is to improve roadway conditions by realigning two curves, demolishing abandoned roadway and facilities, and restoring native vegetation to disturbed areas along 1.2 miles of Mission Road.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Constructing two road sections to replace the existing curves in Mission Road;</li> <li>• Demolishing abandoned roadway and facilities;</li> <li>• Installing a 4-foot by 5-foot box culvert on one section of the road;</li> <li>• Installing a 60-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe culvert in another section of road; and</li> <li>• Realigning the curves on Mission Road, with a final lane width of 12 feet along with 6-foot, class 2 base shoulders placed along both traffic lanes.</li> </ul> <p>Proposed mitigation for this project includes: creating 0.10 acres of wetland; and enhancing 0.08 acres of wetland, 0.15 acres of streambed, and 0.05 acres of riparian habitat.</p>
